



COVID Plan for GCMGCC Events

1. References: State Governments & Local Public Health Authorities guidelines & Motorsport Australia website.
2. It is preferred that venues visited by the club should be open-air or at a place with a COVID plan such as a restaurant or hotel.
3. Attendees are requested to bring their own sanitizing agents. Sanitizing agent should be applied to public tables and seats if used by the attendees.
4. Sharing of personal utensils with other attendees except for those from the same household to be avoided.
5. Food supplied by the club should be served individually.
6. Groups to gather in numbers (groups) as authorised by the State Government at the time of the event.
7. Group sizes at functions must reflect the required numbers stated by any current policy at the time of the event.

Covid-19 Declaration - By entering this run, you as an attendee are declaring you:

- have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 as confirmed with a positive test for COVID-19 (not antibody test);
- are not currently experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19;
- to the best of your knowledge, in the previous 7 days, have not been in contact with a known COVID-19 positive case.
- acknowledge and accept that you will comply with all Government and Motorsport Australia requirements imposed in respect of COVID-19-

If after submitting your entry you do come into contact with someone with COVID-19 or if you start to exhibit any of the symptoms or signs indicating that you may be infected, you will immediately withdraw from the run, notify the run organiser and ensure that any close contacts also do not attend. Should you become ill at or start to exhibit COVID-19 symptoms during the run, you shall withdraw safely and immediately notify the Event Organiser, including identification of others with whom you have come into contact with at the run.
